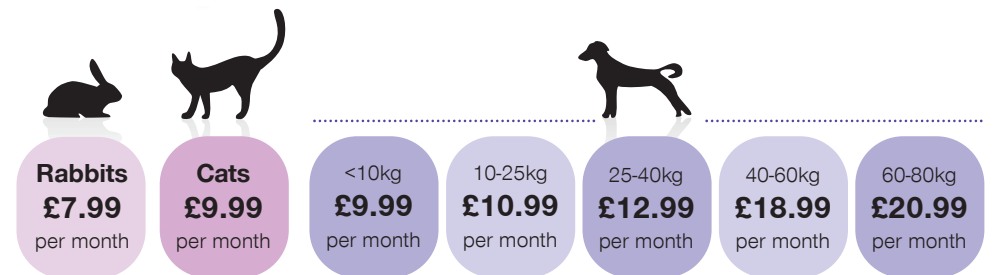
Your Heene Health Plan for Cats and Dogs includes

- Free dietary advice

Your Heene Health Plan for Rabbits includes

- Twice yearly health checks with your vet
- VHD vaccine annually
- Myxomatosis vaccine every 6 months (ideally May or June for best protection)
- An application of Rearguard (prevents flystrike) to be used during the flystrike season.
